1. Previous Minutes.

2. Matters Arising –

Mr Kelly was asking about if he could propose us to dispense his medication. This has been checked with the Medicines Management Team and the answer is it cannot be done as we are not a pharmacy.

3. Doctor's Report.

4. Practice Managers Report

We are going to start Flu Vacs in October and the annual survey will need to be done. 2 dates for the flu vaccinations have already been set in motion in October. Mr Berry, Mr Stacey, Mrs Pygott and Mrs Hodson have offered to come into the surgery to help with the survey this can be discussed between them to set the days they would be able to come in.

We are having a catch up on Pneumonia vaccs and the shingles will also be started.

The waiting lists for certain procedures exceeds the current 18 week referral to treatment time and therefore there is going to be a list sent from the CCG regarding referring patients to other places that have shorter waiting times to facilitate capacity.

Perfect fortnight was successful and another one will be done in the future.

5. **Chairman's Report**

Mr Berry did attend the forum in Scunthorpe. They are going to meet with 2 of the 3 MP's for the area M Daking and M Vickers have agreed to come and have a meeting on 30th September 2016 regarding the funding for GP's.

Health Matters 4 – Mr Berry has had a long chat with Catherine Wylie at this event. There is a new scheme called Parish Nursing which is being looked into. This is likely to be a nurse that is part of the congregation or church and this nurse will go out into community to help people. This could be paid or voluntary.
