Ian Reekie came and gave a talk on Healthy lives and Healthy Futures.

The point of 24/7 hour cover was to be introduced into surgeries; we explained that this would not be possible in our surgery as Dr is a single handed practice and has only one Nurse.

It was brought up in the meeting that some patients have been having a problem when ordering prescriptions on line as it was timing out and they had to go back to the beginning. This problem will be looked into.

If a patient has lost their passwords for ordering prescriptions online they can come back into the surgery and ask for a new password.
